

VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD

BY LAW NO. 27

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD TO AUTHORIZE THE SEVERAL RATES OF TAXATION IMPOSED FOR ALL PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1965.

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village of Glenwood as shown in the Estimates of Revenue and Expenditures are as follows:

Municipal	-----	\$ 11,974.00
School	Provincial -----	\$ 6,979.00
	Division -----	\$ 537.00
Hospital	Provincial -----	\$ 1,073.65
Misc.	Senior Citizens Home -----	\$ 26.00

WHEREAS, the total assessment of land, buildings and improvements amounts to \$269,630.00, and

WHEREAS, the estimated revenue other than from taxation is \$6,608.00 and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are deemed necessary to provide the amount required for all purposes, after making due allowances for the amount of taxes which may reasonably be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by section 353 of the Town and Village Act, being Chapter 338 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, the Council of the Village of Glenwood enacts as follows:

That the Secretary-Treasurer, be and he is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings and improvements as shown on the assessment and tax roll:

Municipal		13 Mills on the Dollar
School	Provincial	26 Mills on the Dollar
	Division #2	2 Mills on the Dollar
Hospital	Provincial	4 Mills on the Dollar

That the Secretary-Treasurer, be and is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rate of taxation on the assessed value of all trades, businesses and professions as shown on the assessment and tax roll:

All Businesses	20 Mills on the Dollar
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READ A FIRST TIME THIS 14TH day of JUNE 1965.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 14TH day of JUNE 1965.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 14TH day of JUNE 1965.
